In Review: Fixing Fused Sentences/Comma Splices/Traditional Run-Ons

- 1. Use a comma with a conjunction
 - Zeus was the leader of the Greek gods, and he was very powerful.
- 2. Place a period between contrasting and/or longer, more complex sentences.
 - Zeus was the leader of the Greek gods on Mt. Olympus. He was very powerful and strong-willed.
- 3. Use a semi-colon between two short and related thoughts.
 - Zeus was the leader of the Greek gods; he was very powerful. OR
 - Zeus was the leader of the Greek gods; indeed, he was very powerful.
- 4. Use a comma between clauses <u>if</u> the 1st clause is subordinate.
 - Because he was very powerful, Zeus was the leader of the Greek gods.
